**GOOSE WATCH WINERY BRINGS HOME TWO GOLDS
FROM INTERNATIONAL EASTERN WINE COMPETITION**

Romulus, NY – February 23, 2015 – Goose Watch Winery, located on the Cayuga Lake Wine Trail, is proud to announce the addition of two gold medals to its accolades from the recent International Eastern Wine Competition in Sonoma County, California.



The International Eastern stands as one of the oldest and longest-running wine competitions in the nation which began in 1975. Last year, for the first time, the competition expanded to create the International "East Meets West" Wine Challenge where it was combined with the West Coast Wine Competition. After a successful year, the two competitions continued this new tradition and awarded 1164 wines.

Goose Watch Winery claimed a total of 12 medals at this year's International Eastern event; four being bronze medals, six silver, and two gold. The gold medals were awarded to the 2013 Riesling Gewürztraminer and the 2013 Diamond. This is the fifth gold medal for the 2013 Diamond including double gold medals from the Long Beach Grand Cru (CA) and the Indy International (IN).

Goose Watch Winery, owned by the Peterson Family, is located on Route 89 in Romulus, NY with a scenic tasting room overlooking Cayuga Lake. The tasting room is open year round with winter hours in effect until April and features an impressive variety of innovative Finger Lakes wines.
