**GOOSE WATCH WINERY'S 2013 PINOT GRIGIO WINS A GOLD MEDAL
AT CALIFORNIA'S NEW WORLD INTERNATIONAL WINE COMPETITION**

Romulus, NY – March 6, 2015 – Goose Watch Winery, located on the Cayuga Lake Wine Trail, was awarded a gold medal for its 2013 Pinot Grigio at Jerry Mead's New World International Wine Competition (NWIWC) this week in California. Altogether the winery claimed nine medals including four silver and four bronze.



Established in 1991, the NWIWC takes place in Claremont, California and is the only competition in the United States where the best wines from each price category are judged against each other in a double-blind tasting to determine an overall best of variety or type. This year's competition awarded 192 wineries from across the world.

This is the third gold medals for the Goose Watch 2013 Pinot Grigio, which also claimed a double gold at the 2014 NYS Fair Commercial Wine Competition and a gold at the 2014 Jefferson Cup Invitational in Missouri.

Other Goose Watch wines that were awarded medals included silver for 2013 Viognier, 2013 Cabernet Franc Rosé, 2011 Cabernet Sauvignon, and 2012 Lemberger; bronze for 2013 Riesling Gewürztraminer, 2013 Diamond, 2012 Merlot, and 2012 Chambourcin.

Goose Watch Winery, owned by the Peterson Family, is located on Route 89 in Romulus, NY with a scenic tasting room overlooking Cayuga Lake. The tasting room is open year round with winter hours in effect until April and features an impressive variety of innovative Finger Lakes wines. Customers can also experience Goose Watch products at the Lake Placid satellite tasting room and retail stores across New York State.
