Goose Watch Winery Recognized at International Wine Competitions for Both Red and White Wines

Goose Watch Winery is thrilled to announce that it won four gold medals from two recent wine competitions, the Tasters Guild International and the Riverside International, for a variety of wines.

The 27th Annual Tasters Guild International in the Grand Rapids, MI judged over 2,000 wines from eight countries. This highly acclaimed competition awarded gold medals to two red wines of Goose Watch Winery, the 2011 Chambourcin and the 2012 Lemberger. The 2011 Chambourcin now has three gold medals including the honor of "Best American Hybrid Red" from the 2014 Jerry Mead International in California.

Where red wines were favored at the Tasters Guild, the Riverside International recognized two of Goose Watch Winery's sweeter white wines. Snow Goose and the 2012 Diamond each claimed a gold medal at the 33rd year of this California competition. This is the second gold medal awarded to each of these wines including the 2012 Diamond's "Best of Class" award from the San Francisco Chronicle.
